

SUNRAYSIA CRICKET ASSOCIATION.
WOMENS MATCH DAY OVERVIEW
2025-25 SEASON TWO DAY.



Ball: 4-piece 142g Kookaburra Senator Ball (white)

Uniform: Colored, the same as the one day games.

Match Time: Commence at 5.30pm with 5.45pm being the latest to commence play.

For every 6 minutes late(after 5.45pm) in starting play 2 overs are taken off the game (1 over is taken off each innings).

Pitch Length: 20.1m (standard length)

Boundary: 50m minimum

Overs: 35 overs per side

Team: Maximum 13 players per match (11 bat/11 bowl & 11 permitted to field at any one time. Players can be interchanged throughout)

No balls: Ball bounces more than twice before reaching the batter.
Ball does not pitch on the playing surface, ball passes the striker above waist high on the full or ball passes the striker above shoulder height.

Match

Result: Due to bad weather and the side batting second is unable to receive its full allocation of overs, the match shall be decided by the team leading at the end of the last completed over relative to the first innings score. Ie: Team A was 25 after 11 overs but went on to complete their innings, the team batting second must pass the same score at the completion of the same over. Team B must pass 25 at the completion of the 11th over

Batting: Players are to retire after reaching 50.

One batter may return if there are 7 players, 2 batters may return when there are 9 players and all retired batters may return when there are 11 players, in the order in which they retired.

The use of helmets is compulsory for players under the age of 18

The team batting first must cease batting at the end of the 35 overs. If 35 overs are not complete, the team batting second shall be entitled to the same overs completed by the team batting first. **Scoring will finish as soon as there is a result. Play may continue without scoring on PlayHQ.**

Bowling: 6 ball overs with no balls and wides to be rebowled to a maximum 8 balls. Final over must contain 6 legal deliveries
Bowlers can bowl a maximum of seven overs
10 consecutive overs to be bowled from the same end to save time

Fielding: No fielder shall be permitted to field (in front of the wicket) closer to the batsman than half the length of the pitch from the Batter.

Fielding Restrictions: None

Lost Time: Game reduced by 2 balls for every minute lost.
