



PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Purpose

The Sunraysia Cricket Association (SCA) expects all players to uphold the highest standards of behaviour, sportsmanship, and respect including players, coaches, umpires, spectators, parent/guardians, media and administrators. This Code of Conduct outlines the behavioural expectations for all players representing SCA-affiliated clubs.

2. Scope

This Code applies to all players participating in SCA competitions, training sessions, club activities, and any official cricket-related environment.

3. Player Standards

3.1 Compliance with Rules

Players must always abide by the rules of the Association in which they compete and the club for which they play. Rules of the game are mutual agreements which no player should evade or break.

3.2 Respect for Umpires

Players must never assault, attempt to assault, or intimidate an umpire.

3.3 Sportsmanship

Players must ensure that behaviour both on and off the field towards umpires, teammates, opponents, and spectators is consistent with the principles of good sportsmanship. Swearing is not acceptable.

3.4 Reactions to Decisions

Players must not abuse, dispute, or react in an obviously provocative or disrespectful manner to the decision of an umpire.

3.5 Conduct and Reputation

Players must conduct themselves both on and off the field in such a manner as not to bring themselves, their club, or the game of cricket into disrepute.

3.6 Respect for Others

Players must act with respect for the Association in which they compete, their club, teammates, and opponents.

3.7 Language and Behaviour

Players must forego the use of derogatory and discriminatory language based on gender, race, religion, or sexual preference.
